July 7-14 - High School Mission Trip

Below is a full recap of our meeting from Youth Sunday and hopefully all the information you need for this Summer's mission trip to Brooklyn. But you may have questions that I'm not thinking about. Make sure to ask those whenever you have them, big or small, so I can help in any way possible.

Mission Trip Meeting Recap

On youth Sunday we had a meeting during second hour talking about mission trip. I don't remember anyone specifically not being there but I promised to right up a recap of everything we talked about for you all regardless.

Schedule Outlook:

Our trip is from July 7 to July 14 to Sunset Park in Brooklyn, NY. We are meeting at **4 AM** on Sunday the 7th at church to depart and make it to our mission sight by 6 pm that evening. We'll pack breakfast and stop for lunch on the way with dinner at the site.

Monday through Thursday we will be serving the Sunset Park community. We'll work with homeless people, families, kids, elderly people, and more, building relationships and serving their needs in God's name. During the week we'll have some opportunities to do some evening activities. YouthWorks, the organization leading the trip, has some planned activities for us but we'll also have the opportunity to be spontaneous once we see how our time unfolds during the week.

Along with those opportunities, on Friday we'll leave the site and have a day of site seeing. We'll go to the 9/11 memorial, Central Park, Times Square, and more, time permitting. That afternoon/evening we'll move to the VRBO we're staying in for the weekend. There's plenty of room for everyone, and we'll stay there Friday and Saturday night. Friday night the kids will have the option of going to a show, TBD, with Dave Howard or a minor league baseball game. On Saturday we'll go to Coney Island for the day. There's a lot to do there and the kids will have freedom to roam around and do whatever they like. They should bring money for any activites they want to do on Saturday, as well as for lunch that afternoon.

We'll leave Sunday morning and return around 6 pm that evening to Third.

Trip Finances:

On Sunday May 19th a \$50 deposit is due for each student going on the trip. Once our fundraisers are all done I'll put together our total amount of group and personal fundraising, minus that from the cost of the trip, per kid, and have a dollar amount still due per student. Some kids might owe nothing and some might have to pay the difference. I'll have all of that figured out and emailed to all of you on Monday, May 20th by the end of the day.

If there is anyone struggling to come up with the full cost of the trip, please get in touch with me as soon as possible so we can work something out. Money should never be a reason that any of our youth can't participate in mission trips or anything else.
